The 36th Annual Free Throwers Boomerang Tournament returns to Delaware, Ohio Saturday August 1! The longest running boomerang tournament in the USA, the Free Throwers was founded by Delaware native and three-time World Champion and 12-time US National Champion Chet Snouffer in 1980.

Since then, the event has served as the host for a record 6 US Nationals and was the site for the historic 1984 USA-Australia Test Match in which the Aussies avenged their shocking 1981 loss to the USA on Aussie soil in the first-ever international Boomerang Challenge.

This year's event will be held at the Delaware Area YMCA Soccer Fields at 1121 South Houk Road. The events kick off at 10:00 AM and will conclude around 7:00 PM. Spectator guides and facilitators will be on hand to explain the events and the personalities on the field.

The big news this year is that world renowned Sports Illustrated® Photographer David Klutho will once again attend the event, this year focusing on the stories behind the players for Derek Jeter's "The Players Tribune" (<http://www.theplayerstribune.com/about/>). The Players Tribune is a web-based forum. Jeter says, "My goal is for the site to ultimately transform how athletes and newsmakers share information, bringing fans closer than ever to the games they love."

David Klutho has featured US Team members **Chet Snouffer, Logan Broadbent and Gary Broadbent** in several of his 3-D Sports Photography books and will once again be shooting the action on the field here in Delaware. Last year's tournament saw the use of high tech drones, aerial shots, 3-D technology and more
