American Red Cross Seeking Donations for Power of the Purse

Powell, OH - The premier event for the American Red Cross this spring is the 5th Annual Power of the Purse, being held on Friday April 22, 2016 in Powell, OH at Bridgewater Event Center. The sold out event features a festive evening that will raise funds to support the critical and life-saving services of the Red Cross in Central Ohio. Presented by Huntington Bank, the event will feature Angela An, from WBNS-10TV. Signature wine will be provided by the Powell Village Winery. 2016 marks the 100 year Centennial Anniversary for the Red Cross in Central Ohio.

The annual ladies night out event showcases a one-of-a-kind live and silent purse auction and will spotlight area businesses in a fun and creative way. New for 2016 is the "Women in Business" pre-reception featuring Leena Madan, COO for geoAmps, a Powell based technology company. Madan was named one of the 2013 Most Powerful and Influential Women of Ohio by the National Diversity Council and will deliver the keynote address during the pre-reception. Sally Hughes, CEO & President of Castor Connection, Inc. will speak during the main event. Hughes is a member of the American Red Cross Tiffany Circle.

In fiscal year 2015, the Ohio Buckeye Region responded to 1,222 local emergencies, assisted military families, installed more than 1,300 smoke alarms, and trained over 56,000 people in lifesaving skills. And, people from this area donated 218,331 units of blood.
