Green Energy Ohio Tour FREE & Open to Public GEO's Big Tour Moves to Spring for First Time 12 Guided Tours Across Ohio & Over 85 Tour Sites

Green Energy Ohio (GEO), the non-profit renewable energy advocate, will showcase clean energy and green design in local area tours on Friday, June 3, Saturday, June 4 and Sunday, June 5, 2016. This 14th statewide GEO Tour event features over 85 Tour sites holding open houses with installed solar, wind, energy efficiency and other green energy technologies. The GEO Tour has 19 Sponsors across 27 Ohio counties. Green Energy Ohio has featured over 800 tour sites across 66 of Ohio's 88 counties over the past 13 years.

The **Tour is FREE to the public** during designated times which are posted at the GEO web site: www.greenenergyohio.org/ost. Visitors can choose from local sites and create a tour that is convenient to their personal schedules. Open house times on Friday, Saturday and Sunday, June 3, 4 & 5 are listed by region of Ohio.

Guided Tours are also being organized in Akron, Athens, Cincinnati, Delaware, East of Cleveland, Medina, Holmes County, Minster, Oberlin, Springfield, Stark County and Wayne County. The Guided Tours are on Saturday, June 4, and some require reservations (see the GEO web site for more details). The full-color, 48-page edition of the **Spring 2016** *GEO News Magazine* is available to attendees on the Guided Tours featuring most of the Tour sites.

"The free GEO Tour is a great opportunity for Ohioans to learn first-hand about the latest in solar, wind, biomass and energy efficiency," Bill Spratley, GEO Executive Director, said. "As federal tax incentives were extended at the end of 2015 and solar prices are at record lows, now is the time to start acting to install solar as well as other cost-saving green technologies."
